**Scholarship Tickets:**

Scholarship Tickets are only available for students attending public schools in the following counties: Bolivar, Coahoma, DeSoto, Humphreys, Leflore, Marshall, Panola, Quitman, Sharkey, Sunflower, Tallahatchie, Tate, Tunica, Washington and Yazoo, as well as any counties in the greater Arkansas and Mississippi Deltas served by Kings Daughters and Sons Circle Number 2 out of Greenville, MS and Community Foundation of Northwest Mississippi.

**Scholarship Tickets are limited.** Public schools may reserve UP TO 50 scholarship tickets for all shows, dependent upon ticket availability.

Reservations are confirmed on a first-come, first-serve basis, and payment must be received in order for a reservation to be complete. To confirm ticket availability, please contact Holly Senter (662-846-4844 or [hsenter@deltastate.edu](mailto:hsenter@deltastate.edu)) BEFORE submitting your order form.

**Reservations:**

All groups must make a reservation and pay for tickets in advance of the show. All individuals in each group must purchase a ticket, **including any teachers and chaperones**. One adult is required for every 20 students. A confirmation receipt will be emailed to the primary contact of your group prior to the show. Your reservation is not confirmed until you have received a confirmation email. Please have your primary contact present your confirmation email upon arrival for admission. Additional tickets can only be added if the show is not sold out. **If parents wish to attend shows with their students, they must be included in the original reservation headcount**; if parents elect to purchase their tickets separately from the group and are not included in the original reservation count, there is no guarantee that parents will be seated near their preferred school group, especially during high-demand performances.

**Payment:**

Matinee reservations are not confirmed until payment or purchase order is received. Payment methods include personal or school checks, money orders, credit cards, and purchase orders. Your payment or a purchase order is required to hold show and seat reservations, so place your order as soon as possible to avoid missing out on a show. There is a \$10 processing fee included on all orders. No cash. No refunds.

**Copies of Show Books:**

Through our Read It, See It, Hear It, Be It program, we offer \$1 books based on each performance. If you would like to purchase copies of books for yourself and your classroom, please include the number of books you would like to reserve and add \$1/copy to your final payment. Books are reserved on a first-come, first served basis. **Seating:**

Seating assignments are made based on the date the reservation is received, size of the group, students' height and ages, and any other special needs.

**Refunds:**

Because we reserve seats for your group and do not sell them to others, we cannot issue refunds. Refunds will only be issued if the Bologna Performing Arts Center cancels an event. If you pay by a purchase order, the NO REFUNDS policy still stands. We will bill out the PO on the day of the performance to your district office.

**Parking:**

Delta State police officers will direct all parking on the day of a show. Please keep your students together or remain on your bus until your entire group has arrived.
